This event, sponsored by Roxy-Pacific Holdings Ltd and Grand Mercure Roxy Hotel since 2011, will be graced by Guest-of-Honour Associate Professor Fatimah Lateef, Member of Parliament for Marine Parade GRC.

Says Mr Edmund Wong, General Manager of TOUCH Community Services, "We started this event in 2011 when we realised that many clients do not have the means or the family to celebrate this festive occasion.

"This year, TOUCH Community Services, together with Grand Mercure Roxy Hotel and NYGBS, have organised a Reunion Dinner to celebrate the Lunar New Year with them."

These foreign students from NYGBS have planned the dinner's programme, entertainment, as well as interact with the clients, who come from TOUCH Young Arrows, TOUCH Seniors Activity Centre and TOUCH Home Care, during the dinner.

Says NYGBS staff, Mrs Kong Fang-Yu, "This is the first time NYGBS has collaborated with TOUCH to help their needy clients enjoy a night out dining with their family.

"We want our girls to know that they can enrich the lives of others who are less privileged, no matter where they may be."

For Yang Yi Bei, a Chinese student currently residing in NYGBS, planning the reunion dinner has helped her in more ways than one.

"Being away from my family, I miss them deeply during Lunar New Year. However, planning for this reunion dinner has kept me busy and gives me a sense of happiness and fulfilment that what I do will benefit the clients of TOUCH.

"This volunteer experience with TOUCH has motivated me to continue serving others. I want to help children who do not have access to education."
